

PRAXIS TESTS INFORMATION SHEET

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board requires the following PRAXIS assessments:

PRAXIS I: Pre-Professional Skills Tests (PPST)*

Applicants must take the PPST in Reading, Writing and Mathematics. The computerized version of the PPST may be taken at participating Prometric Testing Centers (formerly Sylvan Learning Centers) by appointment throughout the year.

Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) K-6, 5-9 or 7-12*

Applicants must take the level that is required for their teaching field(s). However, applicants with K-12 teaching field(s) are to select ONLY one level. Applicants with a middle school level approved teacher education program are required to complete the 5-9 component.

PRAXIS II: Subject Assessments*

Elementary (K-6) applicants (including Early Childhood majors) are required to take the assessments listed for the elementary level. Secondary/specialist applicants are required to take the subject assessment(s) in the education major if the teaching field is listed. If the teaching field is not listed, applicants are required to submit passing scores only for the PPST and PLT.

*NOTE: NBPTS certified teachers may be exempt from all Praxis assessments pending approval of administrative rules. Go to www.htsb.org for updates.
